DURATION

This is 2 day course.

OBJECTIVES

By the end of this course Participants will be able to:

- Understand how to develop a risk management culture within your organisation from strategic, project and operational perspectives
- Use advanced techniques (Early Warning Indicators, Scatter diagrams, CRAMM, Probability trees, Monte Carlo, Radar charts) to enable you to identify, assess and manage your programme/project risks
- Identify the different roles that are needed for risk management to succeed
- Identify what steps you need to take to improve risk management within your organisation

CONTENT

This two-day course consists of the following major areas:

- Introduction to Risk Management
- Principles of Risk management
- Approach to managing risk and developing a risk management policy/plan
- Roles in Risk management (strategic/project/operational)
- Risk management process (identification, assessing, summaries, communication)
- Embedding risk management
- Personal Action Plans

APPROACH

A combination of trainer led and group working to practice the techniques learnt on the course. About 50% of the time will be spent on practising the techniques that have been taught in the earlier session.
